



# LIAM KINSELLA

## Another familiar face to manager Darrell Clarke in Liam Kinsella has joined the Robins' ranks with a new challenge in sight.

The midfielder signed for Cheltenham Town during the January transfer window and was the club's second addition of the month.

"I'm absolutely buzzing," said Kinsella after joining.

"I know the gaffer from our time at Walsall together and I'm just excited to get going now and play for this football club."

Kinsella's time at Walsall spanned 19 years after he joined the academy in 2004 during which time Clarke managed the club between 2019-21.

"From working with him at Walsall, he's a fantastic manager and one of the best I've worked under," Liam continued.

"As soon as I knew there was interest from the gaffer and Cheltenham Town, it always interested me to work under him again and thankfully we got it over the line."

Nevertheless the 27-year-old's time at Walsall will always hold a special please in his heart.

"I had a fantastic time and wouldn't change it for anything. You learn a lot in 19 years. It was a fantastic time in my career and I'm ready to start a new chapter now."

There was a stop at League Two side Swindon Town earlier in the season and although brief, Liam remains thankful for those who

contributed to his time at the club.

"I can't thank Swindon enough for giving me opportunities to play for their football club. The fans, staff and all the football players I worked with at Swindon Town was a fantastic six months I was there."

The desire to play "at the highest level" brought him north to Cheltenham and he has been a distant admirer of the club's change in fortunes since Clarke was appointed in September.

"I saw the start of the season and it didn't go to plan as many of the fans would've wanted but the gaffer has come in now, changed it all up and turned it around completely to put us right in the mix to get out of this trouble."

The Irishman fits the combative midfielder mould that Clarke loves and he believes his traits set him up perfectly for a successful spell with the Robins in their tough battle to survive.

"I like to say I work as hard as I possibly can, break it up in the middle to stop counter attacks and lend it to the forward players to do the magic.

"You want to be as consistent as possible and I try every game I go out there to be as consistent as I can. You get the bad days at the office but as long as you're working your socks off the consistency usually follows."



**2022/23** 18th, League One Fighting alongside Cheltenham Town in a bid to avoid the drop from League One are Port Vale and they are hoping the arrival of Darren Moore gives them the boost they need.

The Valiants are in their second season back in the third tier of English football after a five year hiatus in League Two which was ended by the successful 2021/22 play-off campaign under now Cheltenham hoss Parrell Clarke. The

Staffordshire based club in fact hold the record of the most seasons in the Football League without reaching the top tier and were once managed by Sir Stanley Matthews too.

However, back to the present, and a steady decline under ex-manager Andy Crosby has seen them slip into the relegation zone. A strong start to the campaign saw them sat in fifth after nine games but a run of six games without a win stretching back to a 3-0 success over Blackpool in December means they now occupy 21st spot, a point above the Robins and a point from safety.

Crosby has since been replaced by Moore, the man who guided Sheffield Wednesday to play-off success from the very same league in May of last year.

The squad includes two of the top goalscoring midfielders in the league with Ben Garrity having nine to his name and summer signing from AFC Wimbledon Ethan Chislett having six of his own as well as his eight assists. But the former has been sidelined by injury since the beginning of 2024 and Chislett's importance to the team has grown further after Tottenham Hotspur Ioanee Alfie Devine moved onto pastures new at Plymouth Argyle.

Elsewhere, goals have been hard to come by for the side with no forward having more than James Wilson's tally of three in the league but the duo of Gavin Massey and Tom Sang down the right hand side have provided a source of creativity for the out of form Valiants.

They arrive at the Completely-Suzuki Stadium looking to build on the 0-0 draw they earnt in January of last year and avenge the 2-1 loss they suffered to the Robins at Vale Park earlier this term.

# LAST TIME WE MET





The Robins picked up their first away win of the 2023/24 campaign with a comeback 2-1 win over today's opponents in Sky Bet League One action when the two met earlier this season.

Goals either side of half-time from an unlikely source in captain Sean Long inspired Town to fight from behind at Vale Park in manager Darrell Clarke's return to his former club.

The deadlock was broken in the 32nd minute after a looping corner from the hosts was headed down by Nathan Smith to the feet of former Vale loanee Alfie Devine, who acrobatically hooked the ball past the helpless Luke Southwood from close range.

With half-time beckoning, the Robins hauled themselves level as a trademark long throw from the left hand side fell at the feet of Long who ushered the ball onto his right foot before striking it past Conor Ripley.

The turnaround was nearly complete just seconds after the break as an inventive kick-off resulted in

midfielder Elliot Bonds rattling the crossbar with a right footed strike from distance.

However, Town didn't have to wait long to take the lead as a scramble in the Vale box lead to the ball falling at the feet of Long again and this time his effort took a wicked deflection to loop over Ripley and spark a celebratory huddle in the middle of the pitch.


As time ticked away, it was relatively smooth going for the Robins with Southwood clawing Jesse Debrah's goal bound header off the line and holding tightly onto another Vale header in the dying embers.

Referee Matt Corlett's final whistle ensured the Robins moved off the foot of the table and earned their second win in a week after the previous Saturday's success against Cambridge United.


