see that. It's encouragement that we now must take forward.

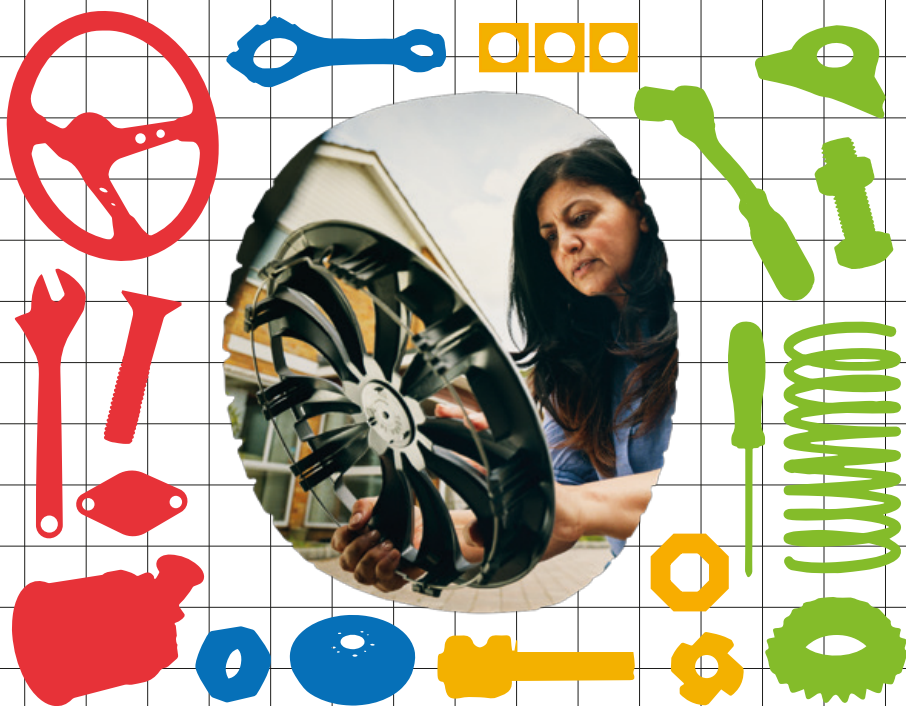

CHAIRMAN DAVID BLOXHAM

I wish to start my notes by welcoming all fans back to the Completely-Suzuki Stadium for our first home League match of the 2023/24 season.

May I also offer a very warm welcome to the directors, players, staff and fans of Bolton Wanderers who have travelled to Cheltenham today for what I know will be an extremely tough test for us against a club who competed in the League One play-offs in May.

Recent games between Cheltenham and Bolton have all been close competitive fixtures. Both clubs gained promotion to League One at the end of the 2020/21 season during which our visitors had an extremely impressive second half of the season to gain automatic promotion together with ourselves and Cambridge United.

The corresponding fixture at the Completely-Suzuki Stadium last season was probably one of the most exciting home games of the season which the Robins managed to win by the narrowest of margins thanks to a late Ryan Broom goal. The reverse fixture later in the season at Toughsheet Community Stadium resulted in a similar score line in favour of the Trotters.

The new season seems to have come round very quickly since our final game of the last season against Charlton Athletic. Off the pitch it has been an extremely busy time at the Completely-Suzuki Stadium with some player and other staff departures and several new arrivals. I should like to offer a special mention to players who have left since the end of last season including Alfie May, Charlie Raglan, Broom and Ryan Jackson all of whom have moved to pastures new as well as thanking other players and loanees who have left or returned to their parent clubs. I thank them all for their contributions and wish them well at their new

clubs. I should also like to welcome our new signings and loanees and wish them well for the season ahead.

As well as player changes, Cheltenham fans will all be aware that our director of football, Micky Moore left for a new challenge after five years at Cheltenham Town together also with Marcus Bignot and our recruitment analyst Tom Ware. Although I and the rest of the board were disappointed that these members of staff left, we wish them well at their new club.

Aside from personnel changes a lot of other work has been going on at Whaddon Road.

Immediately following the last game of the season the pitch was renovated and the new surface laid. Thanks to Matt Utteridge for all his hard work over the course of the close season resulting in the fantastic playing surface that you will see today. Also thanks to his assistant Rob for all his work not only in helping out at Whaddon Road but also the enormous amount of work he undertakes at our training ground.

Other work at Whaddon Road has involved a change in our ground catering suppliers with Rapid Retail having withdrawn from their contract and our new caterers, IGLU, taking their place. I know that Pete Geddes and his team will be working hard to improve the fan catering experience around the stadium.

Fans will also have noted that two new staircases have had to be installed at the canteen end of the HGV Drivers main stand. This was essential health and safety renovation work which has taken a lot

of time and effort to get completed due to structural challenges and rebuilding work. Thankfully that work has been completed in time for the new season which means that the whole of Block A of the Main Stand as well the Paddock area is now fully operational.

We have also spent a good deal of time, effort and money in trying to improve the water supply to the main stand area of the ground. Many fans will know that when we have experienced high attendances the demand on water has been such that the supply has at peak times been insufficient to meet demand. It is hoped that a new supply will be completed shortly to remedy the unsatisfactory water supply issue in this part of the ground.

In addition to all the "headline issues" there have been many other practical and administrative matters that have needed to be addressed during the close season and I should like to take this opportunity to thank my fellow directors and the club's entire staff for their help and support through what has been a very busy period.

Finally as we approach the first home game of the new season I should like to thank you, the fans, for your incredible support which has been clearly demonstrated at this early stage by the demand for our new away "mint" strip and in the additional take up of season tickets which has achieved record sales numbers for the start of a season. Thank you all.

I hope that you all enjoy today's game and the season ahead.

CURTIS THOMPSON

Cheltenham Town's latest signing is a player with bucketloads of experience at this level and Curtis Thompson is eager to demonstrate that to the Robins faithful.

The 29-year-old has been a regular in midfield in Buckinghamshire since 2018 for Wycombe Wanderers making over 150 appearances for the Chairboys. Now in Gloucestershire and at Cheltenham Town, he is keen to leave his mark in a similar fashion.

"I'm delighted to get it over the line," began Thompson. "I want to be myself, enjoy it and do what I do. It is good to be back in the mix and I'm looking forward to playing games again. I can't wait to crack on and do my best."

The Englishman's time at Wycombe is certainly one he looks back on fondly and he finds similarities between his old and new employers.

"It was a great journey," reminisced Thompson. "It was really inspiring. The success the club had was down to the togetherness. It was a big thing at Wycombe. The boys giving their all every day in training. It's a similar kind of feeling to what we have here, punching above our weight."

"They had a few generals in the team, and they led us out and had a lot of games under their belt and

knew what they had to do. Everyone was on the same page."

During his time at the club, Thompson was a second half substitute in the successful League One play-off final in 2020 and prior to that he had won the Player's Player of the Year Award for the 2018/19 season.

Ahead of signing for the Robins, Thompson got a chance to play with his new teammates in the pre-season friendly against Newport County, an experience he credits as beneficial.

"It's always good to get some minutes under your belt and pre-season is all about getting fit and getting yourself in the best shape for the season. Also, it's always good to get a feel for things and play some football with the lads."

Thompson as a player could somewhat be classed as a classic midfielder and one that is desperate to help his team in every effort.

"I like to get stuck in and get on the ball as much as I can and be positive, drive the team and give my best performance in each and every game."

Bolton Wanderers flew out of the Sky Bet League One traps last weekend and have already stamped their authority on the division this season. A Carabao Cup victory over Barrow followed their impressive 3-0 opening day victory against Lincoln City, making it a perfect start to the 2023/24 campaign.



The Whites are many people's favourites for the third tier title this year and they didn't wait one minute to back those claims, as Jack Iredale scored with their first shot on target in the win over the Imps. Striker Victor Adeboyejo also got himself on the scoresheet, an early confidence booster for the forward they signed from Burton Albion back in January.

It was a very positive season for Ian Evatt and the Trotters last season, winning the EFL Trophy at Wembley blowing away eventual League One champions Plymouth Argyle 4-0. Their fortunes wouldn't run the course of the league season however, as they missed out on a return under the arch, after their play-off semi-final defeat to Barnsley.

But the Whites will be taking last season as a vital learning experience to mount another strong challenge, in the aim of returning to the Championship for the first time since 2019. The Trotters have infact been in League Two since their last season in the second tier, having been promoted with Cheltenham

Town during the 2020/21 COVID-19 affected season.

The two sides have locked horns in a number of close affairs over the past few seasons, with last term cooking up two riveting encounters, both of which ending in narrow 1-0 victories for the home sides.

But it's a new season now and Bolton will be aiming to get back to their former heights with a whole host of new faces at the Toughsheet Community Stadium. The likes of Nathan Baxter and the permanent signing of former Robin Dan Nlundulu are sure to bolster Evatt's already strong squad. As will the quality additions of Carlos Mendes Gomes and Paris Maghoma, on loan from Brentford.

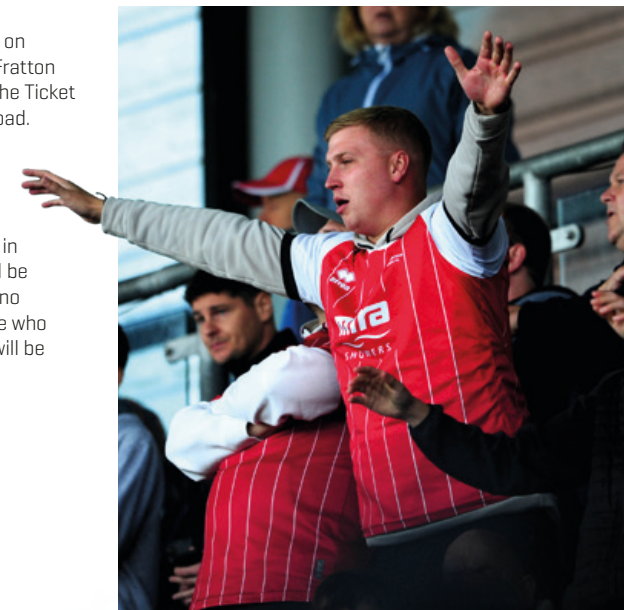
Tickets and travel for our trip to Fratton Park to face Portsmouth on Saturday 19th August (3pm kick-off) are available now online or from the ticket office.
